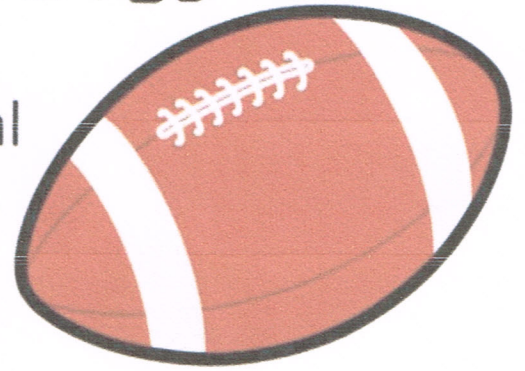

# PAPER FOOTBALL CHALLENGE

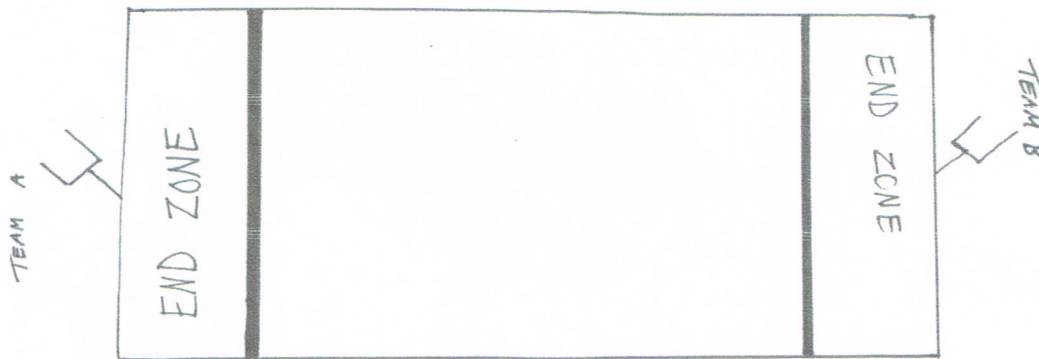
## RULES

### TEAMS

- Four players per team, with one alternate
- Each player will play one quarter of the game in the first round and final round
- Alternate will only play in the absence or illness of another player
- Alternates can be on the floor with their team and act as coach or cheerleader

### GAME PLAY

Games will begin with a coin flip to determine which team starts the game. The team “kicking off” begins the game by attempting to score a “touchdown” by flicking the paper football from behind the line of the end zone on his/her side of the table and into the end zone of the opposing team.



Each turn consists of the active team attempting to score a “touchdown”, worth

# RULES OF PLAY

1. Football must be flicked, not pushed, into the end zone to count as a touchdown
2. Football must not fall off the edge of the table to count as a touchdown
3. Field goals kicked directly after a successful touchdown are worth 1 point
4. Field goals kicked in place of an attempt to score a touchdown are worth 3 points
5. Touchdowns are worth 6 points
6. All touchdowns and field goals must be played from behind the end zone line of the offensive team
7. Only one attempt for a touchdown or field goal is allowed per turn. If the play is unsuccessful, the ball is automatically handed back to the other team

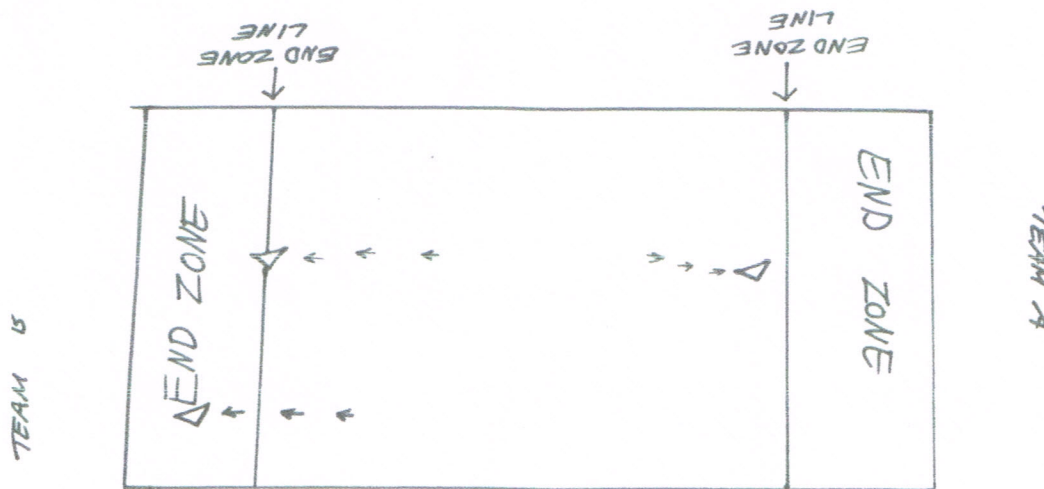

# TOUCHDOWNS:

In order to score a touchdown and receive 6 points the football must cross the end zone *without* going off the edge of the table. Any portion of the football that crosses into the end zone counts as a touchdown.



For example, pictured above, the two paper footballs on the left hand side of the table [having crossed the end zone line] are touchdowns, while the one on the right side is not.

# FIELD GOALS:

The ball must be “kicked” from the offensive team’s end zone, through the goal posts.

6 points. If they successfully score, they have the chance to score a “field goal” for an additional point. If either team decides at the beginning of their turn that they would rather attempt a field goal *instead* of a touchdown, they may kick a field goal\* which will be worth 3 points.

After the entire play is over, (the active team either scores or is unsuccessful) the “ball” goes to the other team, and they try to score in a similar fashion. Play continues until the clock runs out.

\*If a team wishes to attempt a field goal worth 3 points, they must indicate as such to the referee or opposing team captain, BEFORE the play. The 3-point rule only applies to field goals kicked *instead* of a touchdown. Any field goal that is kicked directly *after* a touchdown will only be worth the additional 1 point.

## IN THE EVENT OF A TIE:

If at the end of the allotted time for a game, there is a tie between two teams, a tie-breaker commences. Each player on the two teams is allowed one attempt to score, rotating from Team A to Team B, and so on. After all 8 players have rotated, the team who scored the most points moves on.

## TIME STRUCTURE

Each game between teams runs at 4 minutes.

## MATERIALS

All footballs will be provided by Chick-fil-A the day of the event. Please come wearing your best team uniforms!

## SCORING

- Touch-down = 6 points
- Field Goals
  - Following a touchdown = 1 point
  - Alone = 3 points
